What is Weekend of the Cross?

Weekend of the Cross is an event coordinated through Trinity Methodist Church of Ruston. Approx. 120 teenagers (accompanied by adults) will be working on houses in the Lincoln Parish area for two days. Would you like for your house to be considered? This is the 29th year for Weekend of the Cross in the Lincoln Parish area!! Go to www.wocruston.org to check out our website!

When is Weekend of the Cross?

The volunteers will be working on homes **Friday and Saturday, July 25th, and July 26TH from 9 am to 4 pm**

Do I have to be home during those days to be considered for Weekend of the Cross? Yes!

It is very important to the volunteers that they can spend time with the homeowner and their family. *We ask that you be home at least one of these days.* If you cannot be home both days, please call the church office at 318- 251-0750 to let us know.

What can Weekend of the Cross do for my house?

Because we will only be working two days, the project must not be too large. We will only be able to work on the **outside** of homes - **no interior work**. We can paint the exterior, add, or repair wheelchair ramps, general yard clean up, power washing, or replace deteriorating porches. We will supply all materials.

What happens if my home is selected?

Someone from the team will come out to your home, evaluate your request, and take pictures of the project. Your information will then be passed on to one of our Construction Coordinators who will finalize the plans for your project. Your Coordinator will call you before he comes to visit. Following that, we will give pictures of your house to the Team Leader (an adult that will oversee the work team). If possible, they will come by to meet you before the weekend. Everyone who comes to your home will identify themselves as a volunteer with Weekend of the Cross. They will not need to come into your house if you do not want them to. **What if I would like to do something for the team that is working those two days?**

Many of our homeowners enjoy spending time with the volunteers. That is all that we ask of you, just a little time. However, sometimes homeowners want to do something special for their teams. Some examples would be to make lemonade, cookies, popsicles, or write them a note. We are just thankful for the blessing of serving Jesus Christ and getting to know you and your family. If you have children or grandchildren, we encourage them to play with the teenagers. Some of our volunteers' best memories are playing and working with a homeowner's grandchildren or children. If possible, we would appreciate you making your bathroom available should a volunteer need it.
